Global and domestic supply disruptions, rising logistic and feedstock costs, and continued strong demand for plastic products continue and are supporting this increase.

Brain , what I would like to share what is happening out there and we facing a great price pressure on our feedstock

Current Announced Increases:

January:

Formosa +6

Chevron + 6

Exxon Mobil + 5

Dow + 5

Nova + 6

LBI +6

February:

Dow +7

Current market factors affecting pricing:

- Crude Oil is trading at a 6 month high at \$50/bbl. Factors include anticipated improved demand due to Covid 19 Vaccine and lower production rates.
- Ethylene has increased 12 cpp this month to a level of 42-44 cpp.
- Formosa is in Force Majeure of HMWHD due to a production outage.
- Braskem- Idesa shutdown in December – the plant has partially restarted production of LDPE – but at a fraction of capacity – continued Forced Majeure
- Continued delays in negotiations between Braskem and the Mexican government on Ethylene supply.
- Latin America export business is pulling huge volumes from North America domestic supply.
- Extremely limited offers on wide spec and spot generic prime resin at costs that continue to be pushed up daily.
- Export boom has caused a depletion of North America inventories.

Bottom line:

Booming export demand and very strong domestic demand could drive upward domestic pricing for the next 60-90 days. The January increase looks to be very strong and is expected to be implemented at this point. Earlier buys are proving to be the best buys for the next 2-3 months. Availability of resin trumps pricing for the near future.

I will continue to update you further as I hear of market developments.
