Lee's Summit R-7 School District will not accept proposals that are submitted via email or fax machine. The District reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids and to waive any formalities or technicalities if deemed in the best interest of the District. It is the responsibility of all respondents to review the entire proposal, seek clarification of any item or requirement that may not be clear, and check all responses for accuracy before submitting a response.

Bid price shall include equipment, delivery, set-up and training.

Training shall include at least one (1) session at Lee's Summit R-7 School Facilities Services. The training session shall be conducted at the same time as delivery of the equipment. 4. Respondent shall quote net costs of all goods and services requested and all quotes shall include all transportation to destination and inside delivery.
5. There will be no public opening of the bids.
6. Acceptance of this bid or any part thereof, in writing, within ninety (90) days after the closing date, by the District shall constitute a legal and binding agreement; wherein, the vendor shall furnish the services in accordance with the specifications and offeror's bid on the written order of the District.
7. The District reserves the right to award this contract in its entirety or to split the contract among bidders, whichever is in the best interest of the District. The District may accept any item or group of items of the bid unless qualified by specific limitation of the bidder.
